Topic:

### Tree Installations

- slacklines, ropes courses, tree houses

The use of trees in structures is not a new phenomenon. But the trend has intensified to include trees as a natural experience in leisure facilities. In addition to adventure courses and zip lines, tree houses, even as commercially used tree hotels, become more popular. In many cases, tree experts have to make statements about the suitability of the trees used as a supporting element with regard to technical standards. At the same time, they also should be able to assess the impact of the installations on the living tree and to recommend measures for protection.

As usual, the morning of the workshop will consist of presentations and discussions. The afternoon will be spent on a trip to a near-by ropes course in trees.
